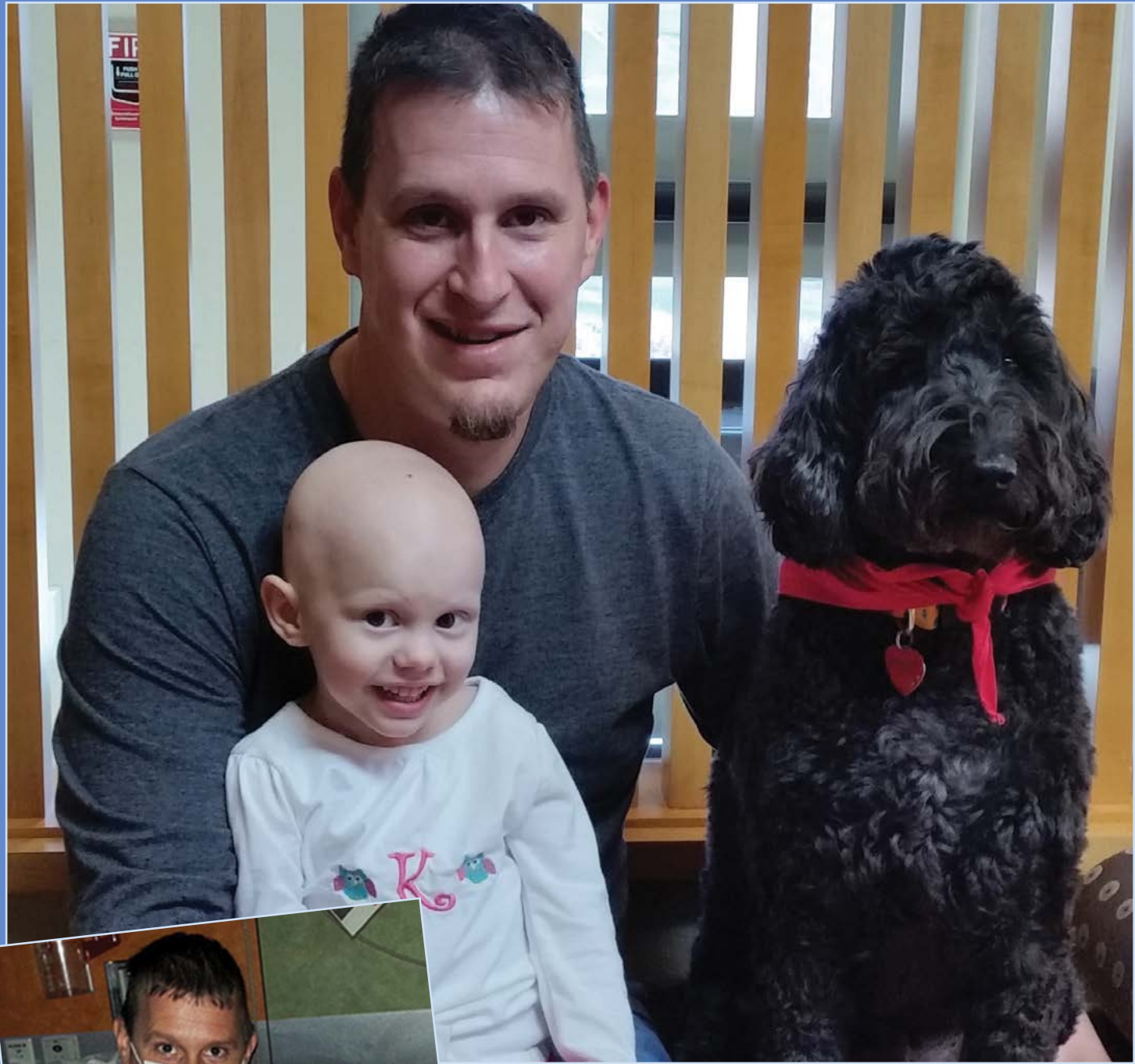

Now, published research conducted by our global office underscores the role a Ronald McDonald House plays in keeping families together during times of medical crisis. Key findings conclude that the Ronald McDonald House program impacts children and families by bridging access to top medical care for seriously-ill children, providing families with emotional and physical comfort and support, improving the child and



family hospital experience and helping to improve the child's recovery. Here at RMHFW, we are grateful for the opportunity to assist well over 900 families each year as their children are receiving treatment nearby. Thank you for helping us continue to fulfill our mission, thereby *Keeping Families Close* when they need it the most.

Keeping the House in the green

National Recycling Solutions (NRS) is one of the fastest growing textile recycling companies in the United States. In 2013, NRS chose the Ronald McDonald House of Fort Worth to be one of its charitable partners. Since then, NRS has donated **more than \$30,000 per year** to the House through their subsidiary, **Recycle 2 Support** (R2S).

“R2S is an evolution out of NRS in order to have a larger impact in the community. R2S allows us to be more available in the community to people who want to properly dispose of the items they no longer want,” explains NRS COO Tammy Wallace. The donors can dispose of unwanted goods, reducing their carbon footprint, and benefit a local charity. “It is truly a win-win-win!”

As one of R2S’s charitable partners, the House serves as a textile donations recipient and R2S converts those textile donations to cash donation to the House. Much of the House’s proceeds from the donations have come from companies organizing clothing drives at their business. This is an effective

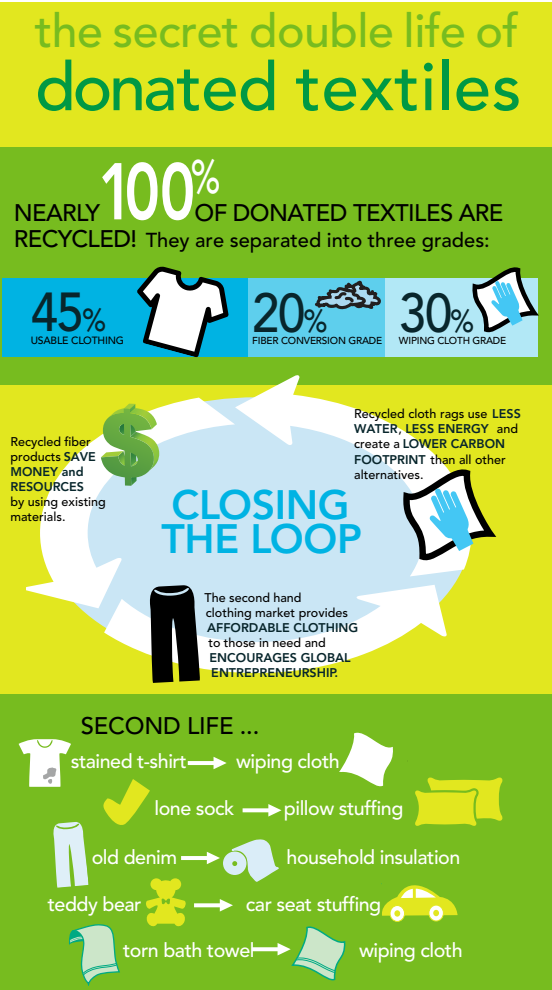
Right now, R2S is working with the Ronald McDonald House of Fort Worth to run a shoe drive. “There is a great need for shoes. We are offering a bonus on this special donation drive over the summer. So for all the shoes RMHFW brings in over the summer, they will receive extra revenue from R2S,” says Tammy.

There are three ways you can donate. First, you can bring donations to the House Monday through Sunday from 8:30 AM to 8:00 PM. Second, take your donations to a R2S location—keep your eye out for a new R2S location opening in Denton this year and a Fort Worth location soon. Third, schedule a pickup by calling 972-619-7899.

What can be donated? Clothes, shoes, small appliances, home goods, etc. “We can take everything except mattresses, large appliances, batteries, paints, and chemicals.”

way to get employees involved in the community and to spread awareness not just about the Ronald McDonald House, but also about R2S and its initiatives.

“It is time to ‘Rethink Recycling.’ We, as a society, are on-board with recycling paper, plastic, aluminum cans and even electronics. We must take the next step and recycle the other items we are not using and stop filling our landfills. It is time to start recycling textiles and household goods.” ***R2S does not want you to throw away that sock that’s missing its partner and those shoes you’ve worn for seven years. You might not think they can be reused, but R2S repurposes those items into other products like wiping cloths, household insulation, car seat stuffing and pillow stuffing. All these items donated to RMHFW, whether you think they can be used or not, help us have a stronger impact with our mission.***


