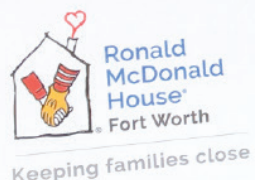

We are immensely proud of the work we do every single day, and it is essential that we share the good work with you. Last year brought much success. Our signature events, Roadhouse and Wild Game Dinner, surpassed all goals, and with our four core programs, we served more than 4,000 families. Fortunately, in June, we reopened in a phased approach and are again serving families in a limited capacity; however, volunteer programs remain on hold. 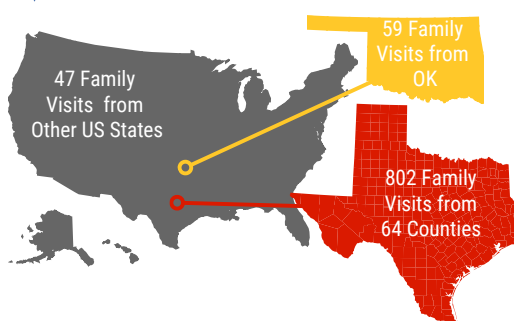
